This tournament is open for players of all skill and age levels.

Event Equipment: Racquets must conform to ITTF regulations (www.usatt.org). “Stag” tables and white Nittaku three-star balls will be used.

Release Forms: All minors under 18 years of age **must** have parent/legal guardian sign the release form.

Special Tournament Regulations: These will be Point System Events. All players will be given a tournament rating by the Director. For every 50 point difference in rating, 1 point will be subtracted from the higher rated player prior to the match. All games will be scored to 11 points. If time allows, matches will be best 3 of 5 games, except in matches where 12 or more points are given, which will be best 2 out of 3 games.

Team Event: Each Team can have two or more players. Prior to the start of the tie, each team captain will designate who will be playing and in which order of play. Only one singles match in the Tie will be with the same two opponents. A maximum of 4 players can play per Tie. If time allows, each Tie will consist of 2 single matches, a doubles match, and 2 additional singles matches. Depending on the number of teams entered, the alternate method will be 2 singles matches and one doubles match per Tie.

Open Singles Event: Following the Round Robin Pools, players will be divided into divisions and continue in a playoff format.

Random Doubles: Partners will be drawn from two pools with the names in the pools selected by ranking.

Tips: Good sportsmanship is expected!! Bring a sports bag, towel, athletic clothing (no white shirts), water bottle and energy food. Please DO NOT bring peanuts or peanut products into the tournament area. This is a peanut free zone.

Food: Snacks, water and sandwich items will be provided by TTY. Food must stay in designated area.

Gluing: No gluing is allowed in the building.

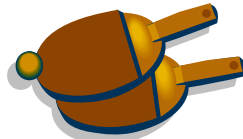
